MASSES FROM SUNDAY 25TH JULY 2021 AT THE PRIORY AND ST. MONICA'S

"Further guidance has been issued for Places of Worship by The Bishop's Conference of England and Wales following the recent lifting of restrictions by the Government.

The continued use of face masks is highly recommended together with the continued use of hand sanitiser and ventilation.

We will continue to follow the measures we have to date and review them regularly.

From Sunday 25th July all the pews on the right side facing the Altar at both St Austin's and St Monica's will be available.

The guidance clearly sets out the need to take account of prevailing local conditions so given the increasing rate of infection and the needs of more vulnerable members of our community **the pews on the left side** will be reserved for those who wish to have more space around them.

The Sunday obligation remains suspended and the Wednesday Mass will continue as now for those who wish to maintain a safer routine with alternate pews on both sides of the Church.

Congregational singing behind masks, and social activities are now permitted and over the next few weeks consideration will be given to how these could be safely reintroduced.

For the time being, only the choir will sing with an incremental increase in the amount of singing.

We are also looking at how teas and coffees after Mass can be safely reintroduced and initially we will be examining ways of doing this outside. "
