**SPUC MASS IN REPARATION FOR THE SIN OF ABORTION** : Celebrated by Bishop Mark O'Toole. 10 am Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> July, Plymouth Cathedral, Wyndham Street West. Newly published Government abortion figures for 2018 show spiralling numbers of babies killed (205,295) with 71% killed by the abortion pill.
